

Parent code of conduct

Our playground should be a safe haven for children, not a place where children and some adults feel intimidated.

As a result, I would politely like to remind you that the school invites parents on to its property by virtue of a licence which the school is within its rights to revoke where a parent's behaviour is threatening or unacceptable in any way. If such behaviour were to occur, the school would have no other option than to immediately withdraw your licence to enter the school premises.

The staff at The Arches have dedicated their careers to helping nurture and support your child. Occasionally, things go wrong, as they do in every school, that need sensitive discussions between parent and staff. Please work with us to resolve matters in a civil manner, as shouting and swearing at staff will not be tolerated and may result in you being barred from the premises.

Parent code of conduct on school grounds:

- See a senior member of staff to discuss any issues in PRIVATE - do not accost teachers/teaching assistants at the school door/school gate
- No smoking/vaping on school grounds or immediately by school gates
- No dogs on premises
- Bad language should NOT be used on school grounds or immediately by school gates
- Be respectful of others views and privacy regarding children's circumstances
- Do not park on the zig zags or in the immediate vicinity of school gates
- Do not park on the pavement
- Do not park across residential drives or access points
- Follow the home/school agreement signed on admission to the school
- REMEMBER - if you have nothing nice to say, say NOTHING AT ALL!
